Final EcoRegion Conference...



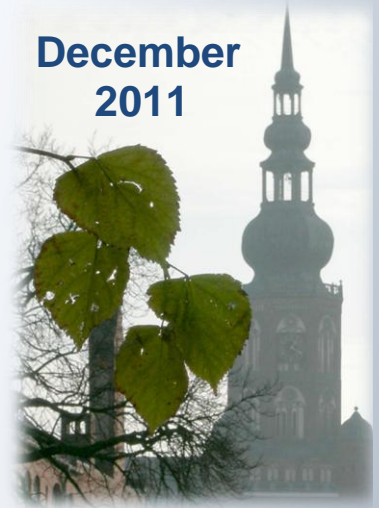
